



# Rosewood Grove questions answered

PORT Rockingham proponents Rosewood Grove has responded to questions put after the recent public meetings to discuss the Public Environmental Review on the project.

A question from June Streeter to the project managers said the extra 288 parking bays would not be enough if the proposal for the 260 multi-storey car park in Kent Street did not go ahead.

Ms Streeter said it seemed

as though the parking issue was being passed on to the Rockingham City Council to sort out.

“At last year’s meeting the marina proposal was dependent on the parking issue to be resolved; to me it has not been resolved,” she said.

A spokesman for Port Rockingham said the issue would have to be resolved in conjunction with the council – a process that would involve fur-

ther community input and give opportunities for Ms Streeter and others to be heard on those matters.

Ms Streeter said one of the pleasures for several people was to swim in the spot where the marina is to be established, every morning from 6.30am in the summer months.

The spokesman said the proponent contended that amenity would be enhanced and beach access completely preserved.
