

# PORT ROCKINGHAM MARINA

Public Environmental Review (April 6th – May 17th 2009)

Rosewood Grove Pty Ltd is proposing to develop a predominantly offshore 500 boat maximum capacity marina in the southern portion of Cockburn Sound, adjacent to the intersection of Wanliss Street and Rockingham Beach Road, in Rockingham.

A Public Environmental Review (PER) has been prepared by Rosewood Grove and their environmental consultant RPS in accordance with Western Australian Government procedures, and is released for public review. The PER describes the proposal, examines the likely environmental effects and the proposed environmental management procedures associated with the proposed development.
